## Perfect Exposure 1.0 – Quick step-by-step User Guide


- 1) Take a light frame with your camera (usually a 5 minutes exposure is enough but you may change it to your like)
- 2) With your favourite calibration software, open the frame and read the average background value
- 3) Open PerfectExposure
- 4) Insert the number of minutes of integration




5) Insert the background value found in 2)



6) Select your camera from the "Choose camera" list. If you don't find it just insert manually your camera gain and readout noise (they are usually provided by the manufacturer).



7) Hit the "Calculate" button



8) Use the "Quit" button to exit the program
